Procedures:

DA and Chain of Command Photographs: By **Appointment Only** - To schedule an Appointment please call DSN: 314-382-5503

No-Fee Passport and Citizenship Photographs: Thursday from 08:00-1200 and 13:00-15:30 hours. Walk-In Basis - No Appointment Required.

General Photography Support: Letter Memo Request - Two or more weeks in advance with explanation on Activity to be photograph (Who, What, When, Where) and purpose for photo coverage. POC and Tel number needed. Requesters will be contacted by the Mannheim Photographer for consultation arrangements prior to an event. Requesters are required to provide the photographer with supplementary information that will be used in preparation of captions and release of the selected material. Captions of events are required by regulation.

Unit activities requiring services from the photo section must complete DA Form 3903 and deliver it to Building #95 on Coleman Barracks; between 0800 and 1530, Monday through Friday, except between 1200-1300 and holidays as far in advance as possible. 



Graphic Training Aids (GTA):

We have a large selection of GTAs in stock for issue. Many GTAs have been digitized. Digitized GTAs will no longer be reproduced and/or distributed. Customers may now download GTAs and reproduce them as required from the General Dennis J. Reimer Training & Doctrine Digital Library.

Download instructions:

1. Go to your local TSC to see if the GTAs are in stock.
2. If not in stock, go to <http://www.adtdl.army.mil/atdls.htm> website on the internet.
3. Look in the Search Forms Box and then the Type Box. Scroll down to "Graphic Training Aids". Look in the School box and scroll to the desired item. Select it and click the submit button.
4. Please **Do Not** go to "**GTA ORDERING ONLINE**". Attempting to order on-line will only delay requests. GTAs out of print can only be downloaded.
5. Scroll down to the desired GTA. Double click to select it.

You maybe required to register to download some GTAs. Paper-based GTAs will not be replaced when the current supply is exhausted. However, we will continue to stock and distribute the GTAs that can not be digitized; i.e., plastic devices, oversized charts, games, etc. These GTAs will continue to be stocked and distributed. Some GTAs are considered a loan item and requesters must be on a signature card to request them.



Acquiring Training Videos:

Please check with the Training Resource Center for training tape availability. Mannheim TRC does not reproduce DA videotapes locally. The Defense Automated Visual Information System/Defense Instructional Technology Information System (DAVIS/DITIS) site contains the searchable listings and descriptions of thousands of audiovisual (AV) productions and interactive multimedia instruction) products used by the Department of Defense.

Account establishment:

Commanders establish a standard account by submitting the following: Assumption of Command Orders, and DA Form 1687 (Notice of Delegation of Authority). Head of staff agencies must provide a memorandum certifying they are the head of that agency in lieu of Assumption of Command orders. This paperwork will be resubmitted upon change of commander or the primary hand receipt holder. Battalion commanders and above may designate personnel in the rank of E-5 or higher (or civilian equivalent) to act as the account holder. No other delegation of authority to account holders is authorized. An account number will be assigned and must be used on all subsequent correspondence concerning the account.
